- 1980 Filed a class-action suit against the Government of Tamil Nadu state in the Supreme Court of India preventing the forcible eviction of pavement-dwellers in Madras, India. The Supreme Court eventually ruled that the state government could not evacuate the residents without providing alternate accommodation.

- Organized the untouchables in order to secure government welfare programs such as sites and services, housing, loans, debt relief, abolition of bonded labor; organized agricultural tenants and landless laborers to create an awareness of land reform legislation and to deal with bureaucratic procedures of land assignment; conducted a socioeconomic survey of condition of a village; engaged in organizing cooperative society for small farmers; organized a basket makers' cooperative for the untouchable tribe of the Koragas in Mukka.
